CATRINAS COSTUME COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Eligibility: The general public can participate. There are two categories: Children (1 to 12 years) and General (13 years and older).
- 2. Costume Requirements: Costumes must embody the traditional characteristics of La Catrina. Participants have creative freedom to adapt and artistically add innovative concepts to their costumes.
- 3. Music and Time: You will have up to two (2) minutes on stage. Please send your music to SOHAILA01@GMAIL.com at least one (1) week before Festival. Music must be 2 minutes or less. Email should stipulate, name of music, if any, and your name or group name that is participating. You will get a confirmation email when received. Please bring back up of music on your iPad/iPod/iPhone just in case.

4. Contest Date: The Catrinas Contest will be held on November 2, 2024, during the Escondido Tamale Festival. Contestants must arrive at the designated area Information booth by 5:00 pm for costume check-in. Contest starts at 5:30 pm.

5. Judging Criteria:

- Originality: Uniqueness of costume design and interpretation of the Catrina concept.
- Aesthetic Value: Visual appeal, including costume details and makeup.
- Creativity: Incorporation of personal or artistic touches while staying true to the Catrina spirit.
- Attitude: Participants should reflect La Catrina's elegance and humor through their presentation on stage.
- 6. Judging Process: Contestants will be assigned a number at registration. Judges will evaluate based on the criteria listed above. Each category will have two judges of recognized prestige, and their decisions are final.
- 7. Awards: Each category will have a first (1st), Second (2nd), and Third (3rd) place
- 8. Code of Conduct: Participants must behave respectfully and cooperatively with other contestants, staff, and festival attendees. Any form of disrespectful behavior may result in disqualification.
- 9. Parental/Guardian Consent (if applicable): For participants under 18, a parent or guardian must sign below to consent to the child's participation in the contest.
- 10. Media Consent: By entering the competition, participants agree that their photos may be used for promotional purposes by USA Multicultural and the Escondido Tamale Festival.
